

khandha (aggregates)

1. rāsito - aggregate
2. Koṭṭhāsaṭṭhotipi - component, portion

(Svāyamidha rāsito adhippeto. Ayañhi khandhaṭṭho nāma piṇḍaṭṭho pūgaṭṭho ghaṭaṭṭho rāsaṭṭho. Tasmā ‘Rāsilakkhaṇā khandhā’ti veditabbā. Koṭṭhāsaṭṭhotipi vattum vaṭṭati; lokasmiñhi iṇām gahetvā codiyamānā ‘Dvīhi khandhehi dassāma, tīhi khandhehi dassāmā’ti vadanti. Iti ‘Koṭṭhāsalakkhaṇā khandhā’tipi vattum vaṭṭati. Evamettha rūpakkhandhoti rūparāsi rūpakoṭṭhāso, - Kandhabhāṅga commentary)

1. rāsito - aggregate
 - piṇḍa - lump
 - Eg :- guḍapiṇḍa (lump of jaggery)
 - pūga - guild, association, mass
 - Eg :- pūgo nāma visum visum samūhā hutvā puññakārino dhammikamanussā. (a group)
 - ghaṭa - pile, heap, collection
 - Eg :- ghaṭanā (a collection of paccayas)
 - rāsaṭṭho - heap, pile, collection
 - Eg :- udakarāsi (heap of water - ocean etc.)

āyatana (Bases)

1. āyatanato - the mind and mental factors strive, make an effort with their own functions in the eye base and visible form etc. (Cakkhurūpādīsu hi tamtaṇḍvārārammaṇā cittacetasikā dhammā sena sena anubhavanādinā kicca āyatanti utṭhahanti ghaṭṭenti vāyamantīti vuttam hoti. - āyatana vibhaṅga commentary)
2. āyānam tananato - Doors and objects extend the mind and mental factors when they are arisen based on its respective door and object. (Te ca pana āyabhūte dhamme etāni tanonti vitthārentīti vuttam hoti.)
3. āyatassa ca nayanato - Because it sends the being to the saṃsāra which has an inconceivable beginning. (Idañca anamatagge saṃsāre pavattam atīva āyatam saṃsāradukkham yāva na nivattati tāva nayanteva, pavattayantīti vuttam hoti.)
4. nivāsaṭṭhānaṭṭhena - dwelling place, living place ("Issarāyatanaṁ vāsudevāyatana"ntiādīsu nivāsaṭṭhānam āyatananti vuccati. Cakkhurūpādīsu cāpi te te cittacetasikā dhammā nivasanti tadāyattavuttitāyāti cakkhādayo nesam nivāsanaṭṭhānam.)
5. ākaraṭṭhena - mine, place of production ("Suvaṇṇāyatanaṁ rajatāyatana"ntiādīsu ākaro. akkhādīsu ca te ākiṇīna tam nissitattā tadārammaṇattā cāti cakkhādayo nesam ākaro.)
6. samosaraṇaṭṭhānaṭṭhena - convergence; coming together; uniting; connecting (Sāsane pana "Manorame āyatane sevanti nam vihaṅgamā"tiādīsu (a· ni· 5.38) samosaraṇaṭṭhānam. Cakkhādayo ca nesam samosaraṇaṭṭhānam, tattha tattha vatthudvārārammaṇavasena samosaraṇato.
7. sañjātidesaṭṭhena - arising place "Dakkhiṇāpatho gunnam āyatana"ntiādīsu sañjātideso. Cakkhādayo ca nesam sañjātideso; tam nissayārammaṇabhāvena tattheva uppattito.
8. kāraṇaṭṭhena - cause ("Tatra tatreva sakkhibabbataṁ pāpuṇāti sati satiāyatane"tiādīsu (a· ni· 5.23) kāraṇam. Cakkhādayo ca nesam kāraṇam, tesam abhāve abhāvatoti.)

Dhātu (elements)

- Because it holds its intrinsic nature. (sabhbāvaṭṭho - attano sabhbāvam dharetīti dhātu
- voidness - (suññataṭṭho)
- Without a soul - (nissattaṭṭha)
(paṭhavīdhātūti ādīsu dhātvāṭṭho nāma sabhbāvaṭṭho, sabhbāvaṭṭho nāma suññataṭṭho, suññataṭṭho nāma nissattaṭṭhoti evam sabhbāvasuññatanissattaṭṭhena paṭhavīyeva dhātu paṭhavīdhātu. – dhātuvibhaṅga commentary)
